HOW 3DE REENGINEERS PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION

- <u>STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP</u> a joint venture combining the core competencies of Pinellas and Hillsborough school districts, Junior Achievement of Tampa Bay, and the local business community.
 - Catalyst for Change -- investments and capabilities that bring innovation from the inside-out
 - Capacity-Building -- supporting existing infrastructure to exponentially increase impact
- <u>REAL-WORLD INTERDISCIPLINARY INTEGRATION</u> linking standards/competency-based and project-based education to driver higher student engagement and academic outcomes.
 - Case Methodology -- expertise in case design as the driving instructional method to provide real-world applicability and integration through all core academic subjects.
 - Turnkey Business Connectivity -- creates authentic integration to the business community and direct management of those external partnerships for consistency and quality.
- ON-SITE TEACHER SUPPORT & DEVELOPMENT partnering to build competencies and capabilities
 - On-Site Support and Coaching -- resources and tools provided for teachers to be able to implement model with fidelity while also providing greater flexibility and autonomy.
 - Transparency & Collaboration -- modeling, observation, and common planning to move through adoption of the model while simultaneously unifying behind mentoring of 3DE cohort.
- <u>EQUITY IN EDUCATION</u> a model designed to serve the diverse needs of ALL students with a strategic focus on lifting our underserved communities.
 - Opportunity -- open to all students, regardless of academic baselines, socio-economic backgrounds or past behaviors. The 3DE cohort mirrors the demographics of the host high school.
 - Replicability -- ability to be delivered across wide spectrum of high school ecosystems.

HOW 3DE PREPARES YOUNG PEOPLE TO SUCCEED IN A GLOBAL ECONOMY

- <u>RELEVANT & EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING</u> interdisciplinary learning that is authentically connected to real world complexities; proven to drive student engagement, foster self-motivation, and raise aspirations.
- <u>MULTI-DIMENSIONAL COMPETENCIES</u> a focus on building higher-order transferable skills for a fast changing economy, e.g., critical thinking, problem-solving, innovation, and an entrepreneurial mindset.
- <u>INDUSTRY EXPOSURE</u> deep exposure to 16 different companies/industries through 9th-11th Grade Case Challenges, Site Visits, and 12th Grade Consultancy Projects.
- <u>BUSINESS COACHES</u> dedicated personnel to advise, counsel, and bridge students to their future opportunities, along with direct interaction with career professionals through classroom advisors and site visits.
- <u>CAREER CONNECTIVITY</u> authentic immersion to real-time challenges presented by local and national employers connecting students to high-growth, in-demand careers in Tampa Bay and beyond.




3DE INSTRUCTIONAL FRAMEWORK

LAUNCHED IN FOUR TAMPA BAY PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS IN AUGUST 2020, 3DE IS AN INNOVATIVE SCHOOL MODEL THAT AIMS TO RE-ENGINEER HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION TO BE MORE RELEVANT, EXPERIENTIAL, AND AUTHENTICALLY CONNECTED TO THE COMPLEXITIES THAT EXIST BEYOND THE CLASSROOM WALLS.

The model operates as a full immersion school-within-a-school with the intention of benefiting both the students within 3DE as well as the broader campus. At 3DE schools learning is more reflective of the realworld by integrating relevant content with business case methodology, interdisciplinary pedagogy, entrepreneurial thinking, project/problem-based learning, and authentic workplace experiences.
